1. In your own words what is sin?

Sin is any failure to conform to the moral law of God in act, attitude, or nature.

Mark 12:30 says “*you love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.*”

Anything that conflicts with this would be sin.

2. Where does Sin come from?

Read Genesis 3:1-7.

Satan, being very enticing, twists the words of God and cons Eve into taking the fruit. Notice verse “5”, what does it say?

Did you ever think that when you sin that you are giving yourself to the position of God? When Eve took the fruit of the tree and ate and then passed it to Adam something happened.
